## Feline Post-Operative Care Instructions

### WHEN YOU RETURN HOME...

- Your cat has had general anesthesia and may be wobbly or tired. If so, please keep them in a confined area for the evening away from other pets and children.
- You may feed your cat when you return home. If vomiting occurs, remove food until the morning.

### FOR THE NEXT WEEK...

- Keep your cat indoors if possible.
- Do not wash or clean the incision. Do not bathe or get your pet wet for 7 days.
- For females, **a small lump under the skin at the incision site is normal.**
- Keep males and females separated. Neutered males can be fertile for up to six weeks after surgery.

We can schedule a recheck if you are concerned about your pet's recovery. Pro Pet Fix will provide a free recheck only for surgery related ailments. Self-inflicted problems (caused by licking, excess activity, etc) may incur a fee. Services rendered by other veterinarians will not be covered by Pro Pet Fix.

### PLEASE CALL US AT (877) 738-3492 IF:

- Your pet is unable to stand or walk 12 hours after surgery, or is not eating or drinking after 24 hours.
- Your pet is exhibiting symptoms of significant discomfort or lethargy 48 hours after surgery.
- There is significant swelling or bleeding at the incision site.
